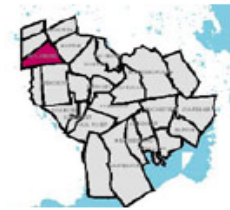

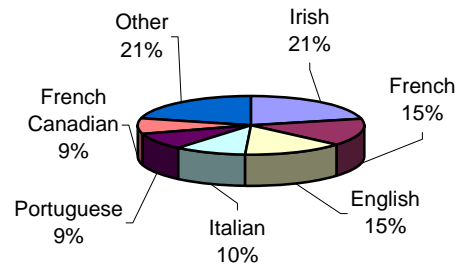

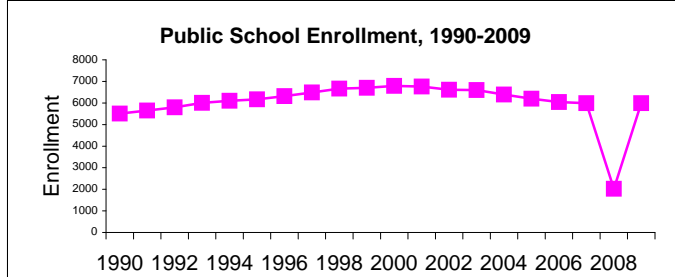

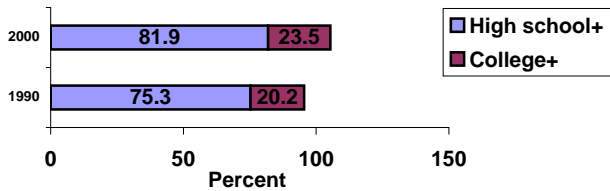

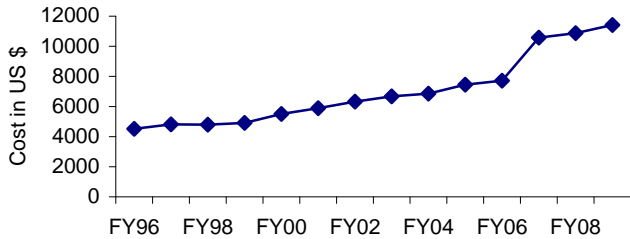

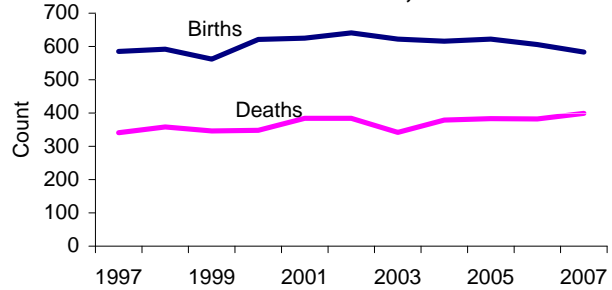
**Cost Per Pupil, 1996-2009**

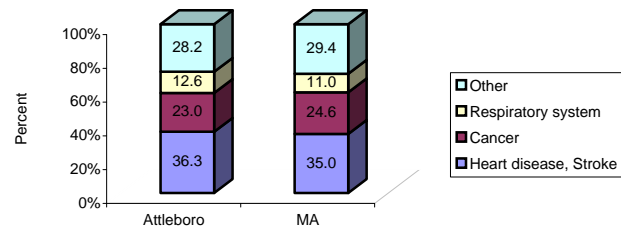

**Number of Births & Deaths, 1997-2007**



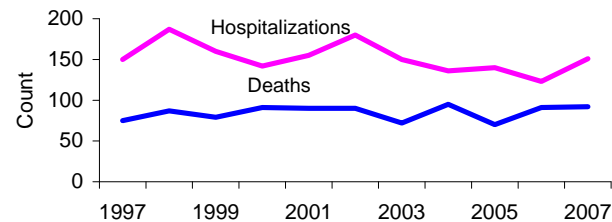

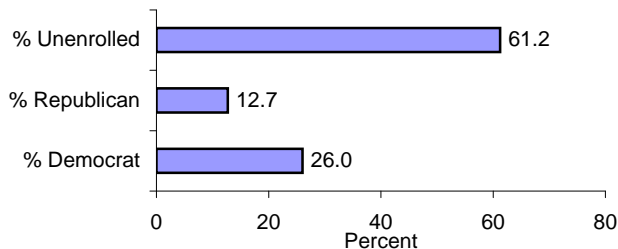
**Cancer Hospitalizations and Deaths, 1997-2007**

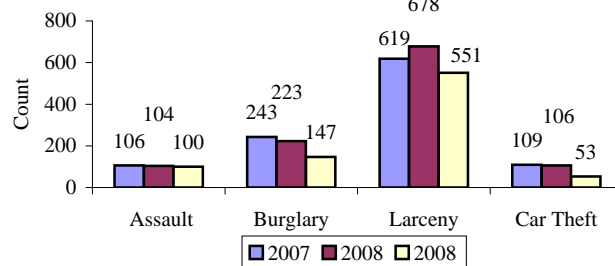
