



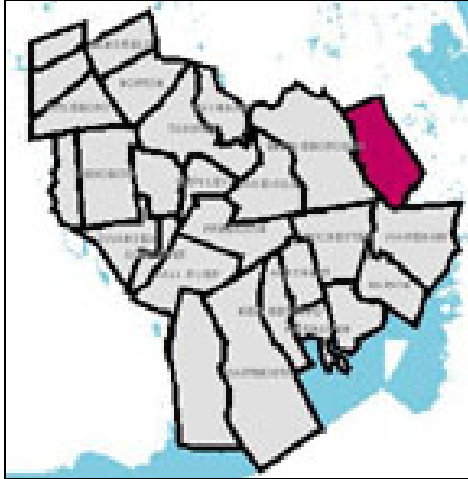

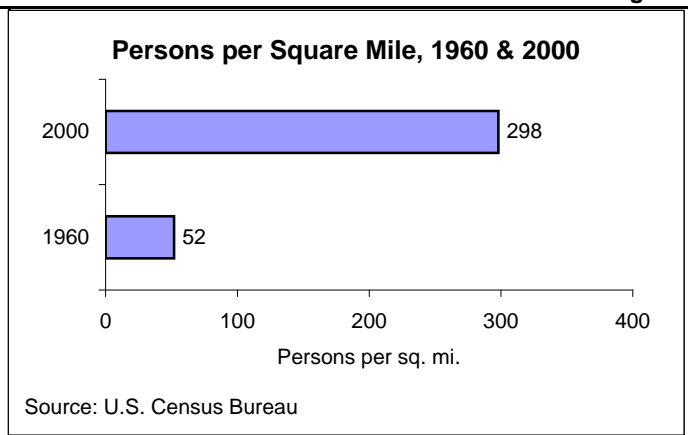
STREET MAP OF CARVER

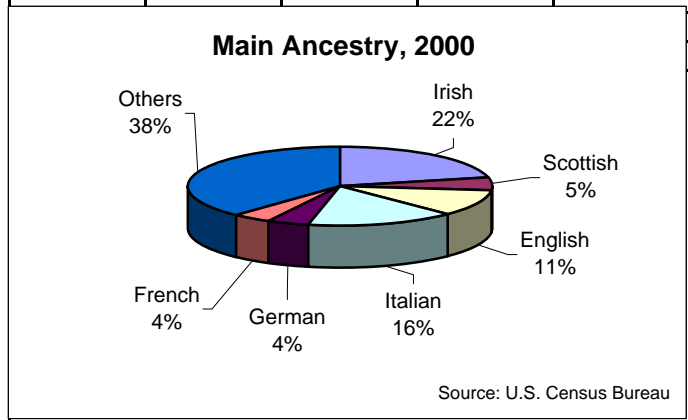
