



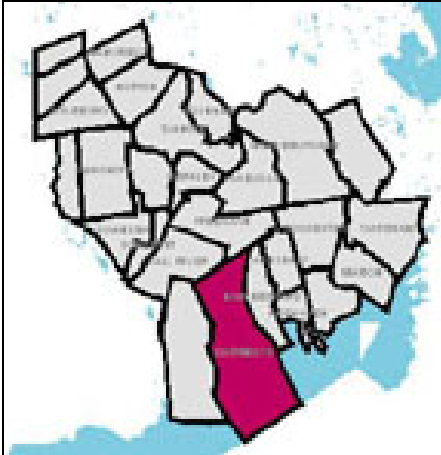

STREET MAP OF DARTMOUTH

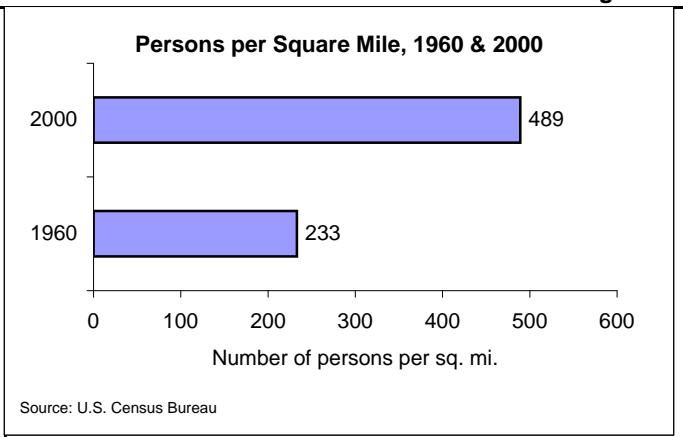

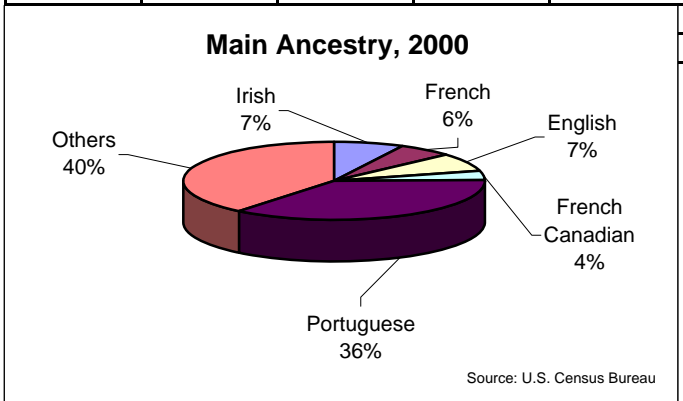

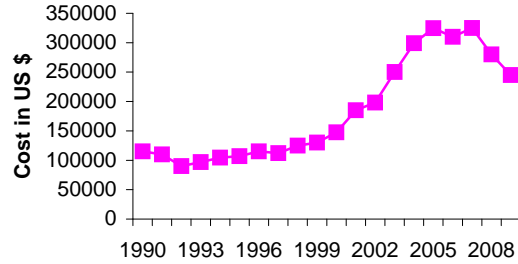

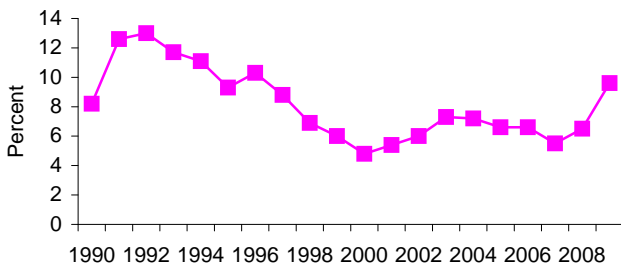

Median Housing Sale Prices (All Types), 1990-2009



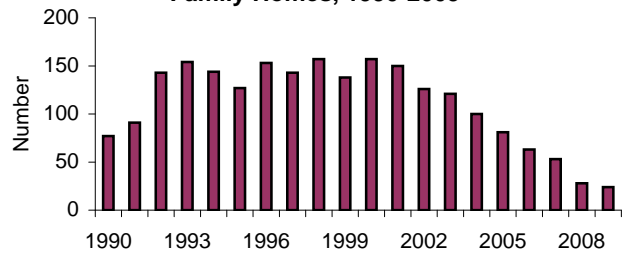

Unemployment Rates, 1990-2009



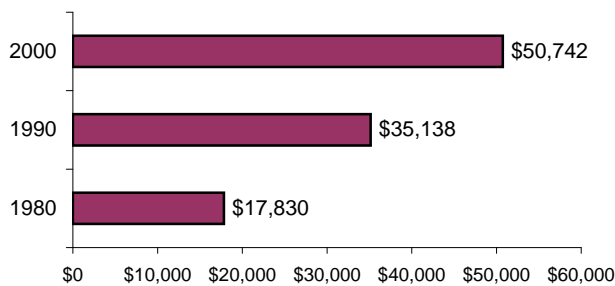

Building Permits for Single Residential Family Homes, 1990-2009



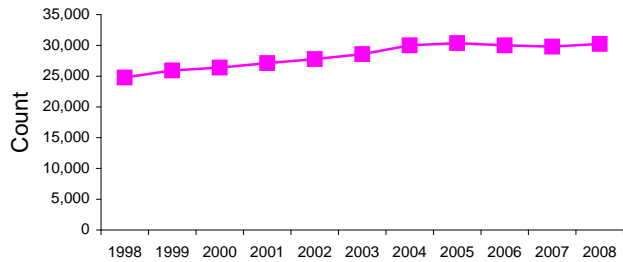

Median Household Income, 1980-2000



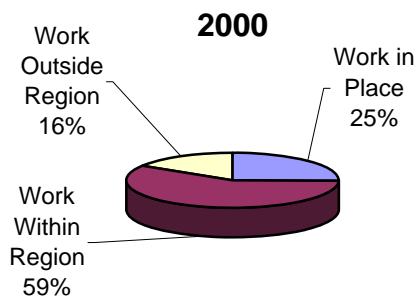
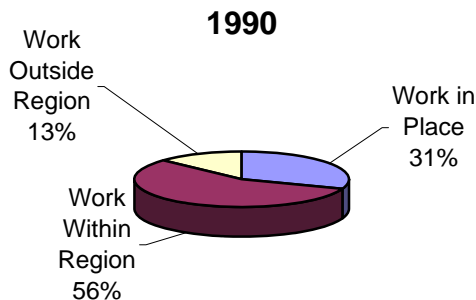
