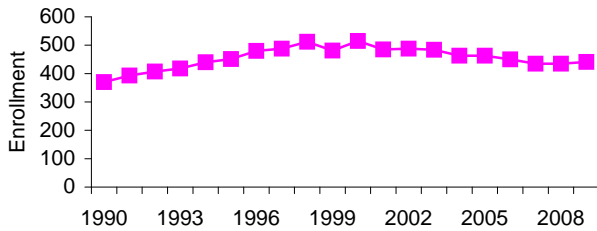

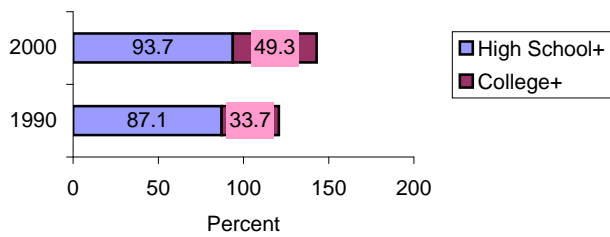

Public School Enrollment, 1990-2009



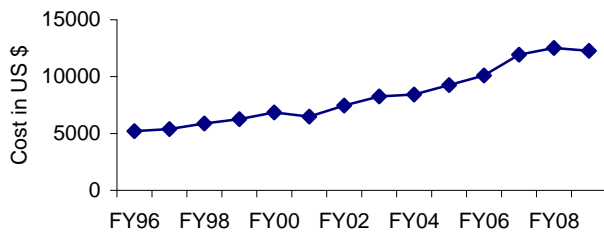

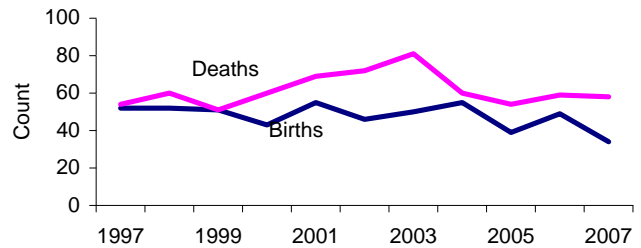
Cost Per Pupil, 1996-2009

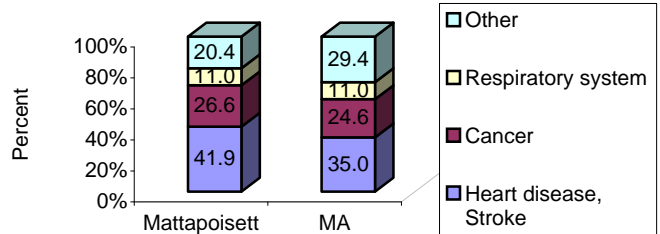

Number of Births & Deaths, 1997-2007



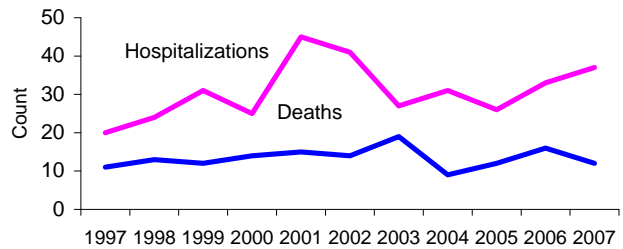

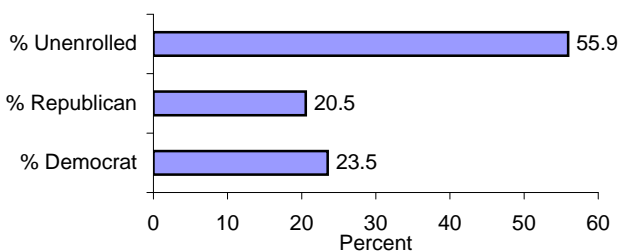
Cancer Hospitalizations and Deaths, 1997-2007

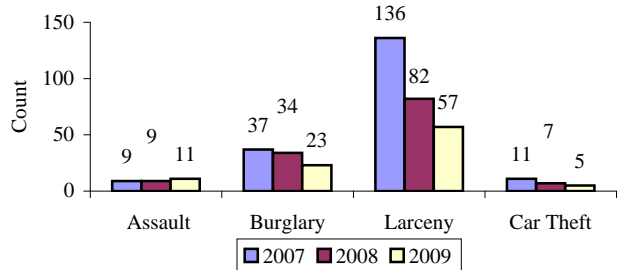
