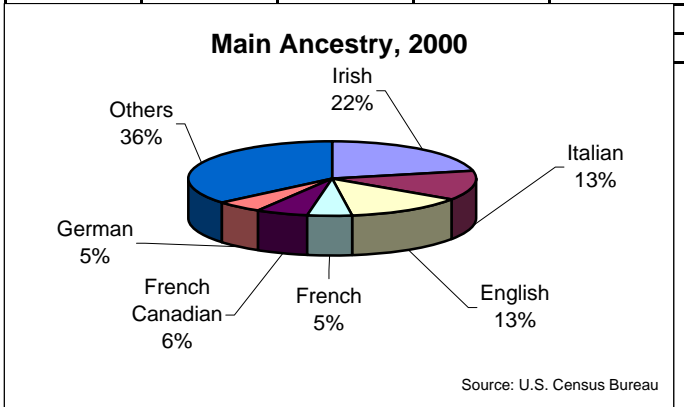

Area Employment by Industry, 2005

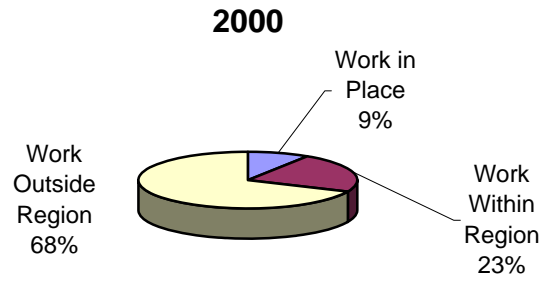
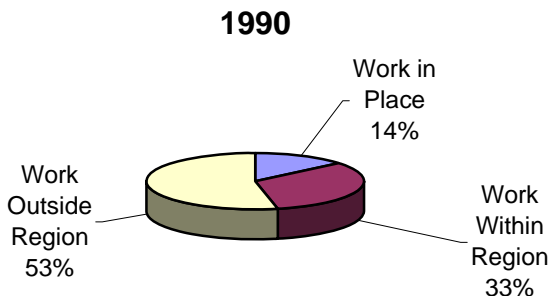

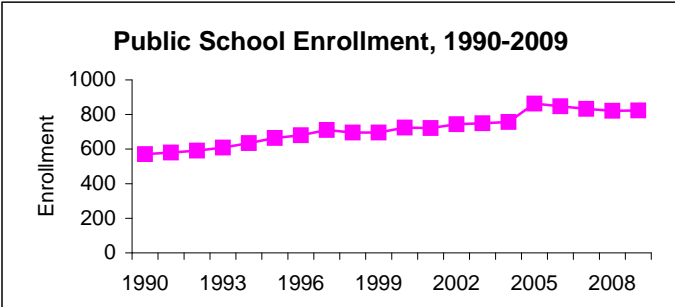
JOURNEY TO WORK, 1990-2000



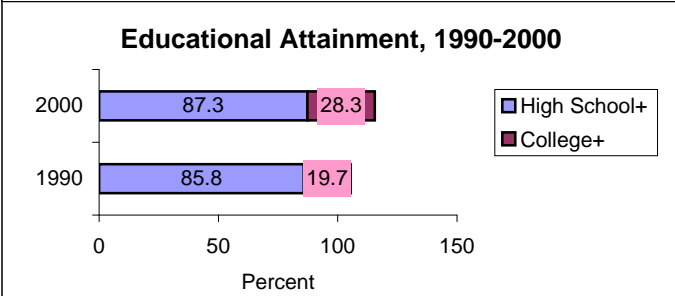
