The data on southeastern Massachusetts towns and cities compiled in this FACTBOOK represent a summary/overview of the type of information that the Southeastern Regional Planning & Economic Development District (SRPEDD) is capable of turning into other formats: maps, graphs, pictorial presentations and illustrations. SRPEDD offers a range of services to the region:

Comprehensive Planning offers: Land use planning; Growth management strategies; Capital improvement planning; Zoning and subdivision regulations; Affordable housing strategies; Visioning workshops; Community surveys; and Fiscal impact analysis.

Natural Resource and Environmental Protection includes: Open space and recreation planning; Watershed protection and planning; Farmland preservation; and Innovative Title 5 septic programs.

Transportation and Transit services include: Computer modeling of current and future traffic flow; Traffic and parking studies; Transit feasibility studies; Pavement management program; Bicycle and pedestrian planning; Safety and congestion analysis; and Traffic counting.

Community and Economic Development services include: Infrastructure grant preparation (PWED, CDAG, EDA); Community development grant preparation (CDBG, CDF, MCCF, HDSP, MIGS); Local economic development plans; Project management assistance; and Site evaluation and promotion.

The ***Geographic Information Systems*** (GIS) accept proposals for Custom database and themes; Custom map production; Technical training and workshops; Global Positioning Systems (GPS); and Municipal GIS needs assessments.

Additionally, SRPEDD offers 1) Volunteer and Board training, 2) Facilitation and public participation, 3) Grant writing and administration, 4) Demographic and economic statistical analysis and projections, 5) Educational presentations on land use, planning, and zoning.
