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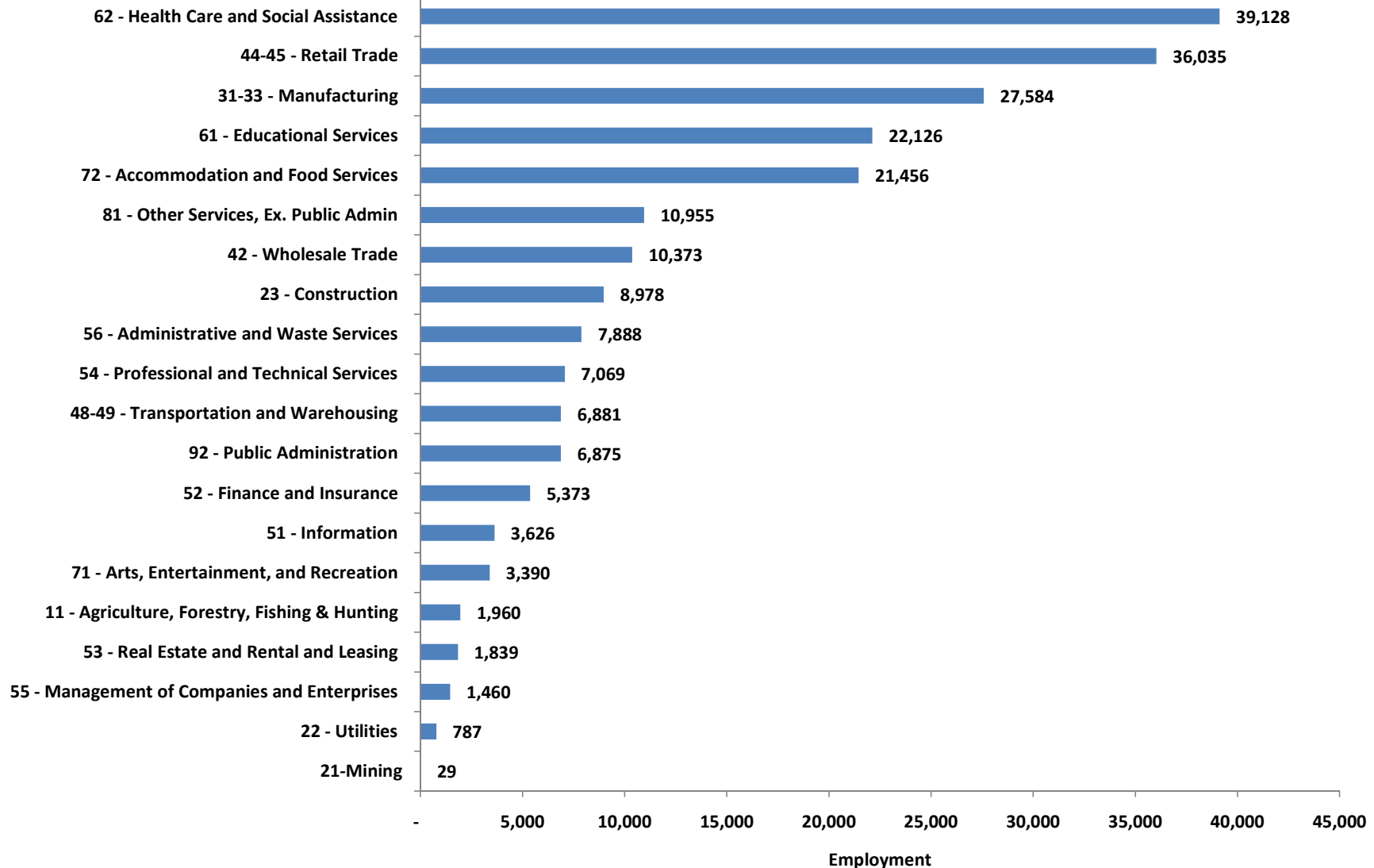

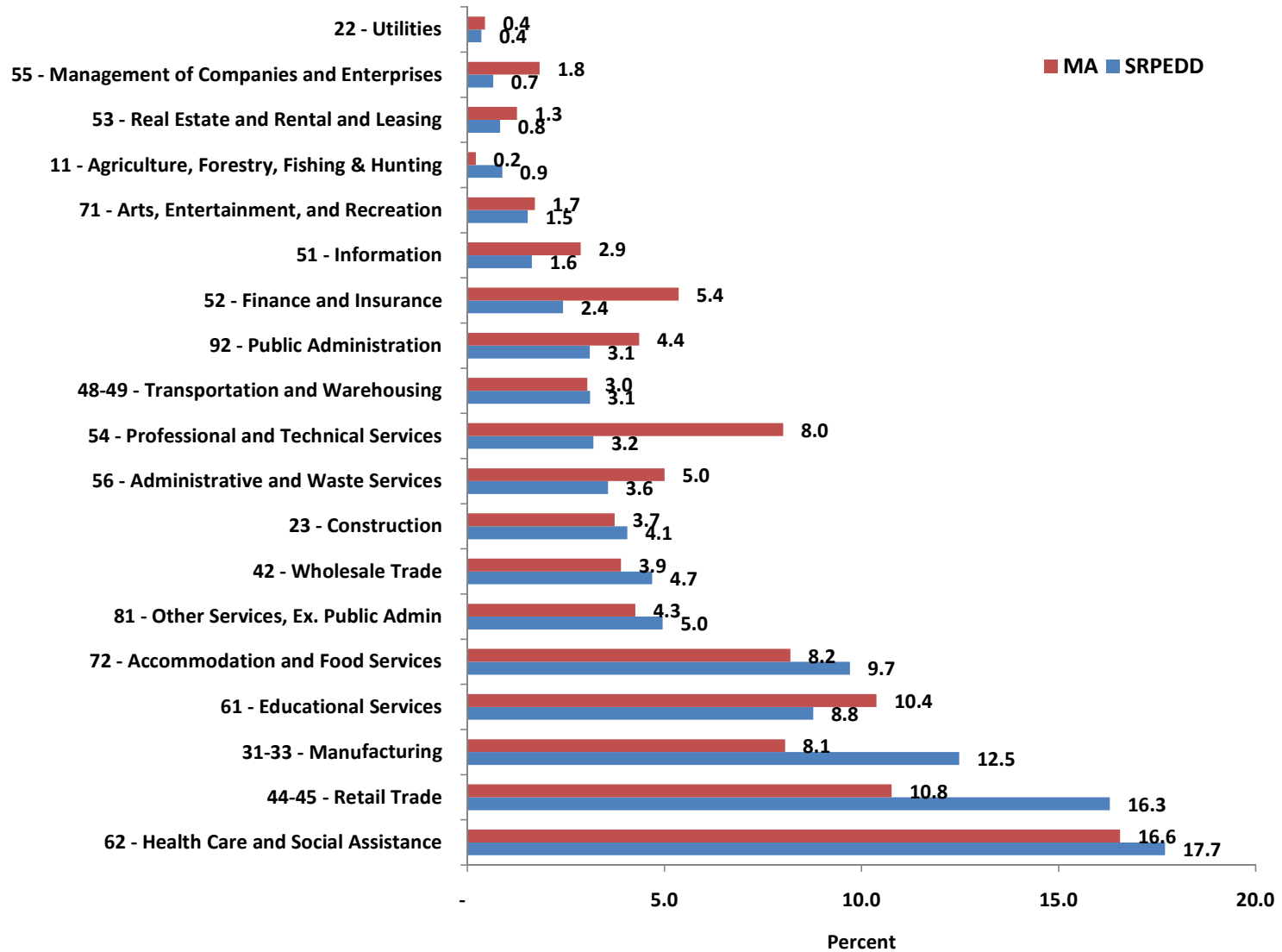

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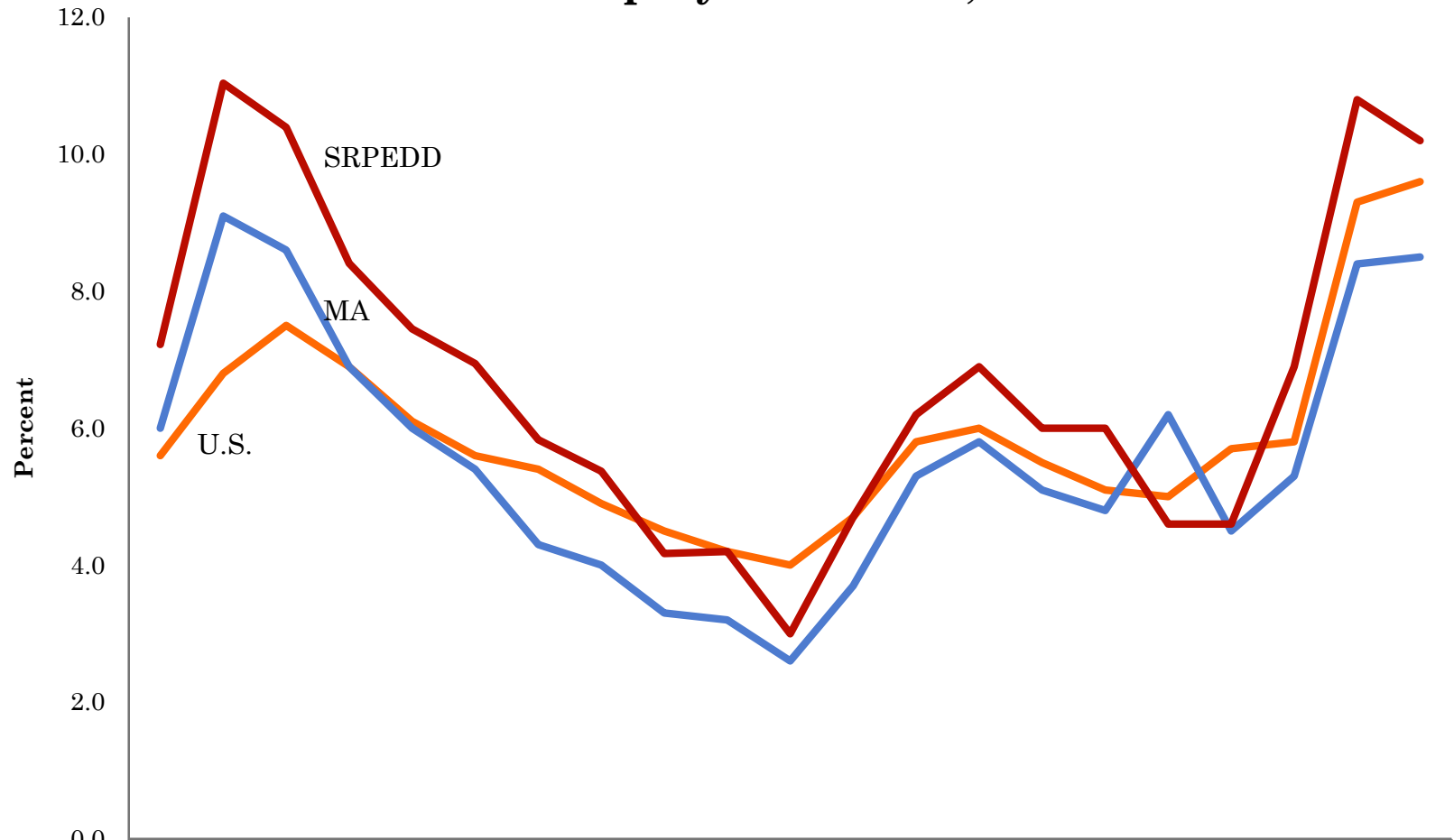

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Trends in Unemployment Rate, 1990-2010

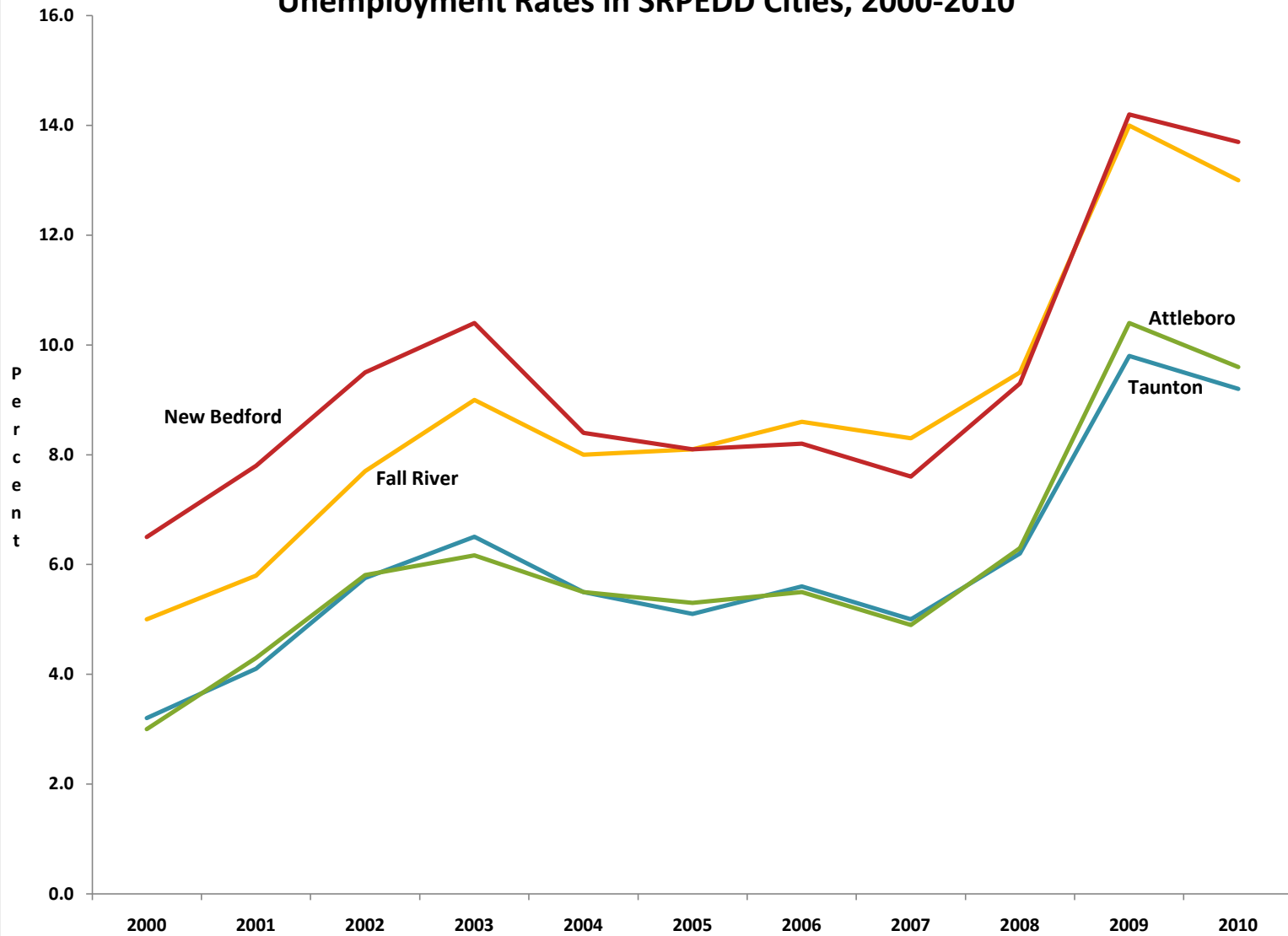

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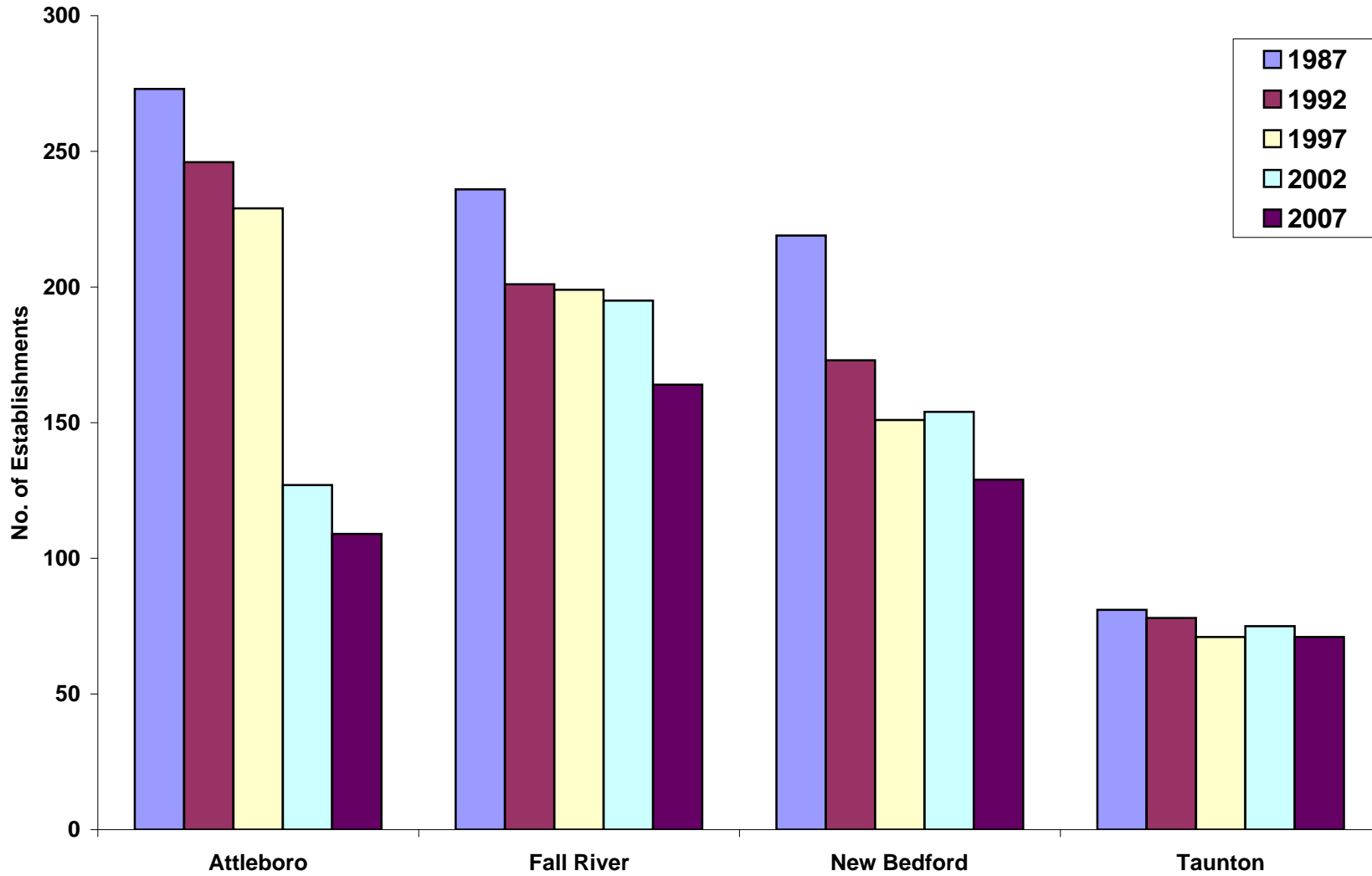

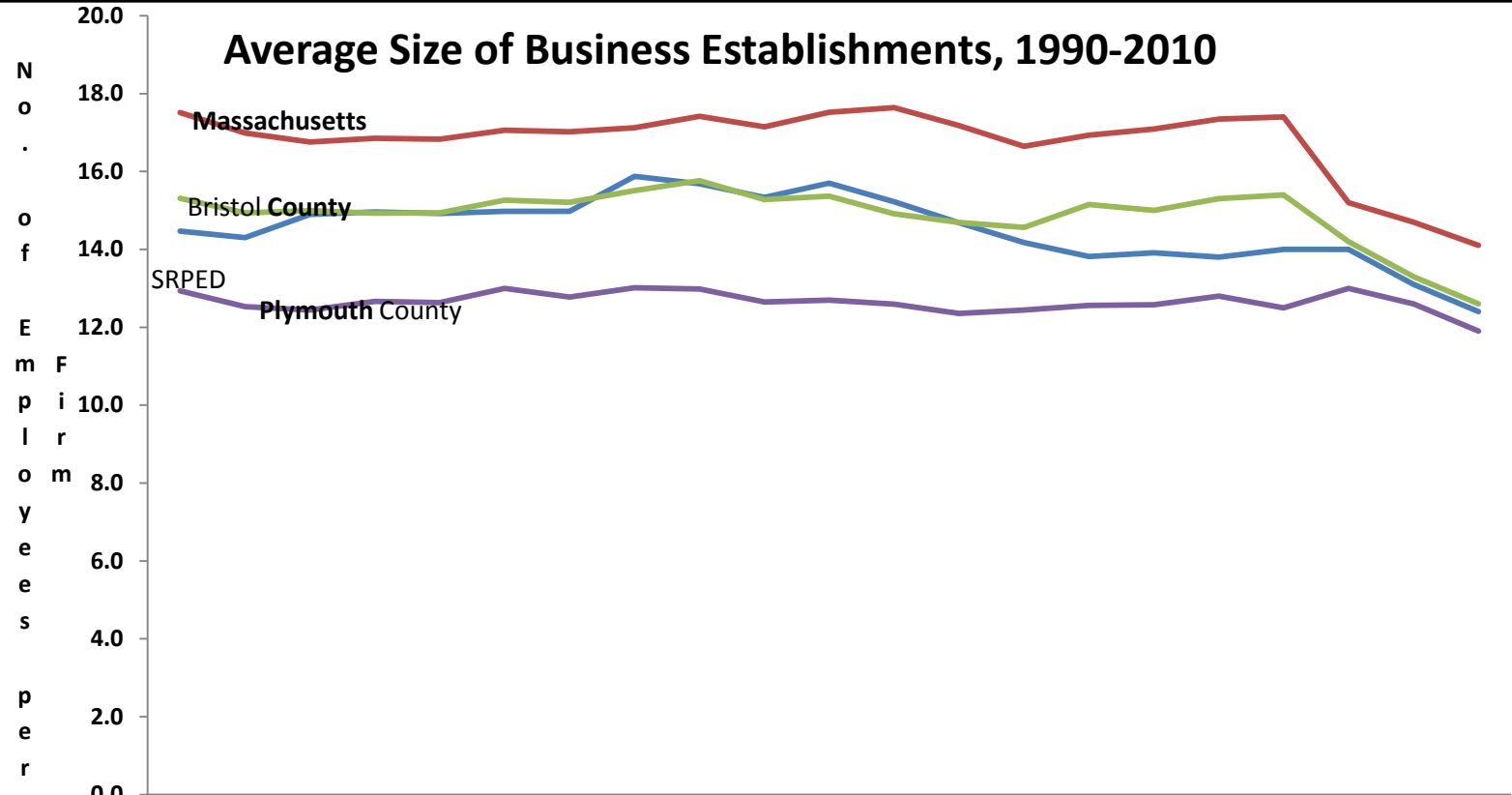
